



- Talk to your child about their day and use questions to extend their thinking.
- Encourage your child to become more independent. For example, dressing themselves, zipping up their coat, putting on their shoes and using a knife and fork.
- Read everyday with your child and talk about the characters and events. Make reading exciting by taking it to different places, for example read in the bath, garden or in a den!

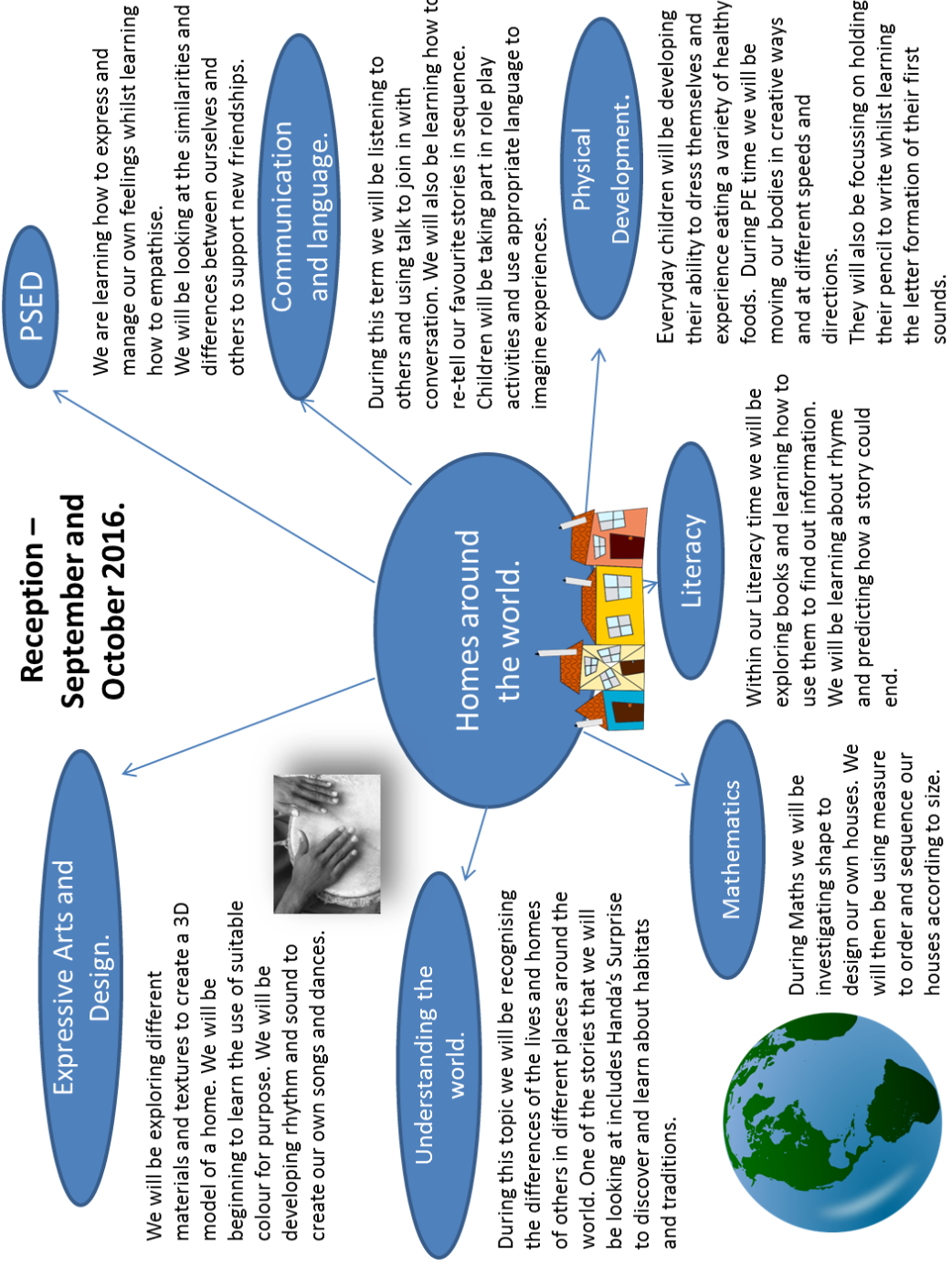
