INSTRUMENTAL TUITION

At Indian Queens School we offer instrumental tuition through Music Cornwall. Music Cornwall provides instrumental and vocal tuition at all levels, in all styles and in all disciplines to schools, colleges and music centres throughout Cornwall. Music Cornwall offers weekly lessons with a qualified music teacher.

Currently both guitar and brass tuition is available. If your child would like to learn an instrument two things are important. Firstly your child would need to remember to bring the instrument and music in each week on the correct day. Secondly it would be important to recognise the additional practice that he or she would be required to do at home if the tuition was to have an impact on their progress.

Termly lessons normally run for 10 weeks each term at a cost of £4.88 per lesson, £48.80 per term. This is paid via the school at the beginning of each term, details of which will be given on request. However reductions are available if you are in receipt of certain benefits. Further information is available from the school office.

Instrument hire is also available at an additional cost for brass instruments. It is recommended that a child size guitar with nylon strings is purchased for guitar lessons.

If you would like any further advice please do not hesitate to contact the school and ask if you may speak with a member of staff who will be able to answer any queries. Playing a musical instrument is a wonderful skill to develop and one to give careful consideration to.

MUSIC CLUBS AND GROUPS

Each term children may apply to attend after school clubs all of which are currently run voluntarily by staff members. These clubs vary from term to term, but usually include at least one music club. In addition, various music groups such as musical theatre, choir, ocarina, rhythm and rhyme are available during the school day for children who show an interest in and an aptitude for music.
