Visit to Pendennis Castle, Falmouth on Friday 13 October 2017

As part of our topic work this term we are planning an exciting visit to Pendennis Castle on Friday 13 October. The visit will involve studying the history of the castle and how it has changed over time. This visit links very well with our current work on World War II as we will also look closely at the defences built during this time. We will travel to Falmouth by coach and minibus, leaving school shortly after the start of school in the morning, and returning to school at approximately 3.00pm.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink, though their morning snack (playtime picnic) will be provided. If your child normally has a pre-paid meal, a packed lunch will be provided by the school kitchen, and we will plan this with your child. School uniform, a waterproof coat and sensible walking shoes must be worn and no pocket money will be required.

In order for the visit to be possible, we are requesting a voluntary contribution of £3.00 per child. Should sufficient contributions not be forthcoming we regret that the visit will not take place. The school is no longer able financially to subsidise school visits more than has already been allocated due to severe financial constraints, so should the voluntary contributions not be forthcoming we regret that the visit *will not take place*, in which case we will inform you as soon as possible.
