VISIT TO LANHYDROCK HOUSE AND GROUNDS

As part of this term's work studying how people lived in the past, and identifying insects and pond life, we are very pleased to inform you that we are planning for Year 3 to visit Lanhydrock House and Estate on:

Tuesday 3rd July 2018

The children will be looking around Lanhydrock House in order to gain an understanding of how people used to live in the past. They will also explore the Estate and complete a pond dipping activity in order to identify a variety of insects and mini-beasts, as well as discovering how they thrive in their natural habitat.

We plan to leave school just after the start of the day and return by the end of the school day. The children will travel by coach to Lanhydrock and seatbelts will be worn. Children will need to bring a packed lunch with them, though their morning snack (playtime picnic) will be provided. Those children in receipt of free school meals will receive a packed lunch provided by our school kitchen. School uniform should be worn, as usual, and no pocket money will be required. Please be aware of the weather conditions- if the weather is wet, the children will need a waterproof coat and footwear which they do not mind getting muddy. If your child does bring alternative footwear, they will still be required to bring clean shoes to wear around the house. If the weather is sunny, please make sure that they have suitable protection from the sun, including a hat and sunscreen, as they will be spending a significant amount of time outside.

A voluntary contribution of £3.00 per child to help with the costs of this visit would be very much appreciated. Should sufficient contributions not be forthcoming we regret that the visit may not be able to place.
